

Memories from Dr D P Jakhanwal, Former Principal and HOD, Department of Physiology. MGM Medical College & Hospital, Jamshedpur

Almost 63 years back in Nov. 1960 Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Medical college was established as Bihar's 1st private medical college, it was a brain child of Indian Medical Association, Jamshedpur.

We respectfully remember few of its (IMA) active member doctors of that time, Dr. S R Sharma, Dr. S K Ganguli, Dr. S B Singh and many more for their commendable efforts for successful completion of this project initiated by IMA Jamshedpur.

During 1950s or 60s, whole of India had only 28-30 medical colleges, and were mostly owned / run by the state / central Government. Contribution of Private run institutions were insignificant especially in north Indian states, few of them were present in southern states.

General conception of technical education being managed by state was very much pre-dominant in (undivided) Bihar also. Initially IMA Jamshedpur was not getting any support either from the Govt or the Tatas. However, with its herculean effort, IMA Jamshedpur was able to come-up successfully with its dream project and Tatas came forward in big way with all possible support.

MGM Medical college, Jamshedpur started its 1st phase 1st MBBS classes at IMA Hall, Sakchi, Jamshedpur. Later, after 2 years, sometimes in 1963, it was shifted to its own new building, at Dimna.

To run the Pre-clinical subjects of 1st MBBS classes Dr. D P Jakhanwal (Physiology), Dr. Chitre (Bio chemistry) were some of teachers initially got appointment as fulltime basis while department of Anatomy was run by part time teachers mainly the IMA members.

Dr G B Sahay was the 1st Principal of this College. Dr H P Sinha took charge from him after his retirement

Later on for Clinical Teaching, Tata Main Hospital and Jamshedpur Eye Hospital were empaneled, which was an essential criterion for the IMC recognition. During mid 80's, after takeover of all the medical colleges of Bihar by the State Govt. of Bihar, the Local Subdivisional Hospital situated at Sakchi was upgraded and named as MGM Medical College Hospital. Now a new 500 bedded hospital building is also being constructed at Dimna, adjacent to existing College building. Strating as an under graduate medical teaching college, in last six decades has grown into a post graduate teaching institute. The Medical college was started with a vision to produce good medical professionals who can serve the society and It has fulfilled all the dreams of its founders and mottos of the its establishment.

HISTORY OF ESTABLISHMENT OF MGM

MGM MEDICAL COLLEGE, the early years.....

Inputs: From My Father (Late Dr S R Sarma) and Sir Dr Jakhanwal (ex HOD Physiology MGM)

Dr S R Sarma came to TMH in 1939 and left to start his practice in 1947. He soon got involved in the social fabric of a relatively young town and realized that education was lacking. In the late 50s, while he was in the governing body of Jamshedpur Co-Operative College with Mr Madan, the idea of establishing a medical college came up. He proposed this to the IMA, and with Dr Ganguly and Mr Madan founded the college and with herculean efforts the first classes started at the IMA hall in Nov 1961 with 50 pioneering students from India and across the world!!

Bihar's first private medical college was born in Jamshedpur, away from city limits at the picturesque foothills of Dalma hills, on land donated by the then chief minister Shri Krishna Sinha.

By third year, the college building was ready and the college could finally shift to its present place.

The problem of clinical attachment and teaching was solved when Dr Sarma met Mr JRD Tata and requested him to allow clinical rotations of MGM students in TMH. Mr Tata asked him - how will the hospital benefit? To which he replied: the doctors will become teachers and get a rank of a medical college faculty! This appealed to Mr Tata and as we all know the rotations started in TMH and later at the then Sadar Hospital in Sakchi.

The college attracted the best teachers from all over India and we all know how we have benefitted from their knowledge and zeal in the pre and para clinical departments. Dr Sahay was the first principal and then Dr HP Sinha followed by a series of luminaries Dr Mrs Nijhawan, Dr CR Banerjee, Dr R K Sharma to name a few.

Gradually the student hostels came up with the picturesque Dalma hills in the background and students shifted from their makeshift hostels like Talwar Building, the building opposite Hotel Rajhans and Jaiswal Building !!

There was a tradition of students coming in the evening to Dr Sarma's home at Circuit House Area to celebrate Holi in the evening! Dr S R Sarma remained the President of the Governing Body of MGM, aided by a very able team, till 1978 when all private medical colleges in erstwhile Bihar were brought under government management.

The dream of having an attached hospital in the same campus as the college is finally taking shape now!

Long live MGM and alumnus

His talks and appreciations for 90 batch seniors and super seniors was never ending , he loved them so much , no doubt he was the pet junior of most of the boys.

I will be missing something huge if I don't mention his laughter which was never ending and super contagious and his temperament of least bothering about trivial things - not my circus , not my monkeys suman he used to say. खुश रहो आज - that's practically all that matters ! I never saw him cribbing or lamenting over things even when it wasn't just or in his favour ! Whistling his way joyfully he completed his medical school , internship and house job and donned the uniform.

A very well decorated officer a man of true grit , honesty , strength of character and huge fun to be with was lost at a very young age on 3rd day of nov 2011.

Manoj met death like an old friend , there wasn't a trace of fear or anxiety , Suman yaar , movement order aa gaya he said ! To accept is true bravery he taught !

He will be remembered fondly , loved beyond measure and the pride of having him as my best buddy will shine bright till eternity.

Memories of a legend

DR JAGDISH TRIPATHY

(1929 to 2022)

MD, MRCP, FRCP (Edin. and Glasgow)

Ex-HOD Medicine Department, TMH

Ex-Professor of medicine (MGM Medical College, Jamshedpur)

Ex-Director Cancer Hospital, MTMH, Jamshedpur

Late Dr. Jagdish Tripathy was a renowned Sr. Physician of International repute. He died at the age of 93 years in TMH, due to multi-organ failure and cardiac arrest. This brought an end to an illustrious era.

Dr. Tripathy was born in Jamshedpur and pursued his medical career from Cuttack Medical College and then MRCP and FRCP from Edinburgh and Glasgow.

He had a brilliant career. He joined TMH as a House Surgeon and later became HOD of medicine department. He was also professor of MGM Medical College, Jamshedpur. Dr. Tripathy was a good teacher with strong knowledge of medicine who shaped the career of many. He was my father and Professor also who taught and guided me in my career. Dr. Tripathy was revered for being a caring, hard working and astute physician (also physician of Rusi Modi Ex-MD Tata Steel).

He believed in update of academics and was examiner to various universities (namely Utkal and Delhi University). He was visiting professor to various universities in USA and Europe.

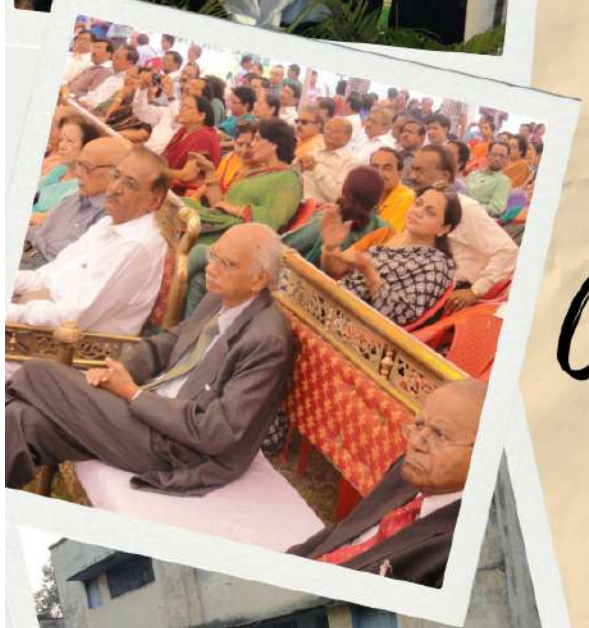

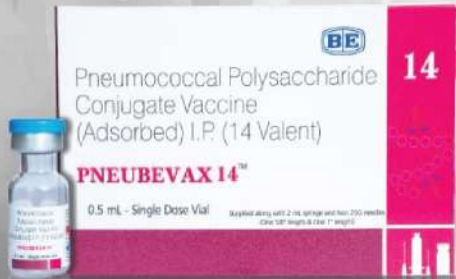

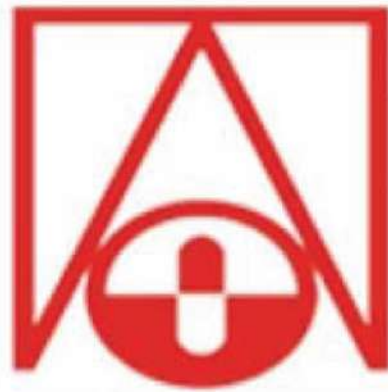
